

2019 Season in Review by Bob Selzler

Although our 96th lawn bowling season was only 4.5 months long before the cold and snow set in, we sure did pack a lot into our season! Some of our significant club accomplishments include:

• Growing our membership to 133, thanks to the addition of the Pride Lawn Bowling League who joined our club after 15 seasons at Inglewood. Welcome Pride Lawn Bowlers, such a fun group to join our club!







- Managing a very successful Casino on the weekend of June 14th.
- Receiving a New Horizon Grant which was used to build new lockers, purchase new sets of bowls, and we also ordered a new outdoor sunshade system. An application has been submitted for another grant in 2020.
- Establishing favorable pricing with Aero Bowls in Australia and organizing a large group purchase of 38 sets of bowls for club bowlers across Alberta!
- Greatly increasing our sponsorships this year thanks to the generous support of:

- Increasing our corporate rentals this year and hosted 14 large groups, 3 small groups and 3 local charities. Approximately 750 total bowlers participated in these bookings!
- Creating a full schedule of club leagues, jitneys, social bowling and scheduled practice times this season, including: Calgary City Pairs League, Social Bowls night, Jitneys, Pride Lawn Bowling League, 2-4-2 League, Cut-Throat League, Ultimate Bowls (Drop-In), and our Sunday morning Junior Program. We also hosted a City-Wide Tea & Jitney, 3 club trophy jitneys (Canada Day Trophy, Lorne Stout Trophy, and Pain Trophy), plus 3 club championships (Doubles, Singles and Novice).









- Hosting 7 provincial events this year:
 - Alberta-BC Test Match (May 31-June 2) featuring some of the top young players competing in Singles, Mixed Pairs, Men/Women Pairs & Triples, and Men/Women Fours.



- o In June we were proud to have hosted 2 ASRAB (Alberta Sports and Recreation Association for the Blind) events for the visually impaired.
- Bowls Alberta Women's and Men's Singles Championships on July 19-21.
- o Bowls Alberta Mixed Pairs Championship on July 26-28.
- On August 12, Canadian National Head Coach Terry Scott, conducted a short training session for some members of the Alberta Development Squad and the National Team. He then followed that up with a meeting with Alberta Club Coaches for updates on coaching.
- o Bowls Alberta Junior Fun Day on August 24.
- Providing lessons to 5 clients from the Developmental Disabled Resource Centre during August and September.
- Welcoming many visitors to our club, including memorable guests from Nanaimo, Hong Kong, Brisbane, Australia and New York City.

On August 3-4, Specialty Turf Care and the Calgary LBC hosted their annual August Invitational Tournament –24 triples teams, with players from all over Alberta. This is always such a fun 2-day tournament, bowling while rocking out to music,

enjoying adult beverages (not on the green), great competitions, excellent food, and socializing before, during and after the games! On September 1 we started a very successful new 1-day tournament, the 1st annual Mary & Henk Open Mixed Pairs (Women Skip) tournament. 24 teams for clubs across Calgary and Medicine Hat registered in 2 different pools (Tournament Players or Social Players) and played 3 x 12-end games. All entry fees went towards prize money and there were also door prize draws for many non-prize winners.
