



# ***Bowling Guideline for Wet Conditions***

## ***1. Bowling in Wet Conditions:***

- Bowling is permitted if it is wet, using common sense.
- Stop playing if it becomes too slippery, too wet, or if the greens are being damaged.

## ***2. Use of Groundsheets:***

- Place the mat directly on the green, not on the groundsheet, to prevent slipping.
- Groundsheets can be slippery when wet. Step carefully on them when delivering.
- Avoid walking on the groundsheets.

## ***3. Moving Groundsheets:***

- Move groundsheets up and down every few ends to avoid them staying in the same place all evening.

## ***4. Player Positions:***

- Players not actively bowling should stand on the bank, not on the green.
- Especially avoid standing in the area behind the t-line.
